

Certificate in Dental Radiography

National Exam Board for Dental Nurses

Overview:

Dental nurses are required to undergo training for taking radiographs. This programme offers the chance to learn about the theory of using X-rays safely and demonstrates the practical aspects of taking common dental radiographs. It is designed to prepare for the theoretical part of the NEBDN Certificate in Dental Radiography. Once obtained, this qualification entitles the Dental Nurse to take radiographs in a practice unsupervised.

Objectives:

To provide employed qualified dental nurses with an opportunity to acquire underpinning theoretical knowledge and practical experiences leading to the NEBDN Certificate in dental radiography.

Who should attend:

Qualified Dental Care Professionals (DCP) who would like to become more actively involved in patient care and have aspirations to articulate towards becoming a dental radiographer.

Duration:

30 hours over 10 weeks – day release.
