

Certificate in Dental Radiography

National Exam Board for Dental Nurses

Overview:

This course supports Dental Care Professionals (DCPs) to gain the National Exam Board for Dental Nurses (NEBDN) Certificate in Dental Radiography qualification. The programme delivers the theory of dental radiography as detailed in the NEBDN syllabus and it is expected that the practical aspects of dental radiography will be taught by the DCPs practitioner. Once practical skills have been developed and the theory of dental radiography is understood DCPs can present for the NEBDN Certificate in Dental Radiography examination. Once obtained, this qualification entitles the DCP to take radiographs in dental practice or clinic.

Objectives:

To provide employed qualified dental nurses with an opportunity to acquire the underpinning theoretical knowledge associated with the NEBDN Certificate in Dental Radiography syllabus.

Qualified Dental Care Professionals (DCP) registered with the General Dental Council who would like to become more actively involved in patient care and have aspirations to articulate towards becoming a dental radiographer.
