

NEBOSH General Certificate

Aims and Objectives:

This is broad based management training designed for all levels of employers and employees. It concentrates on the management of occupational safety and health. There are no pre-entry qualifications, but individuals must be prepared to assimilate a large amount of information with regard to safety in the workplace.

Objectives:

- To have a good awareness of all types of workplace hazards and risks
- To implement a comprehensive Health and Safety management system
- To set practical Health and Safety objectives and be able to plan and implement means of achieving those objectives
- To carry out risk assessments and be able to set appropriate control measures
- To carry out full safety inspections and audits within workplaces
- To provide adequate information, instruction, training and supervision for all employees within the workplace
- To investigate all incidents involving injury or damage in order to determine the causes and to take appropriate remedial actions
- To communicate effectively on Health and Safety issues with superiors, employees, and Health and Safety professionals
- To understand the main legal requirements relating to employers and managers and to act to fulfill these obligations
